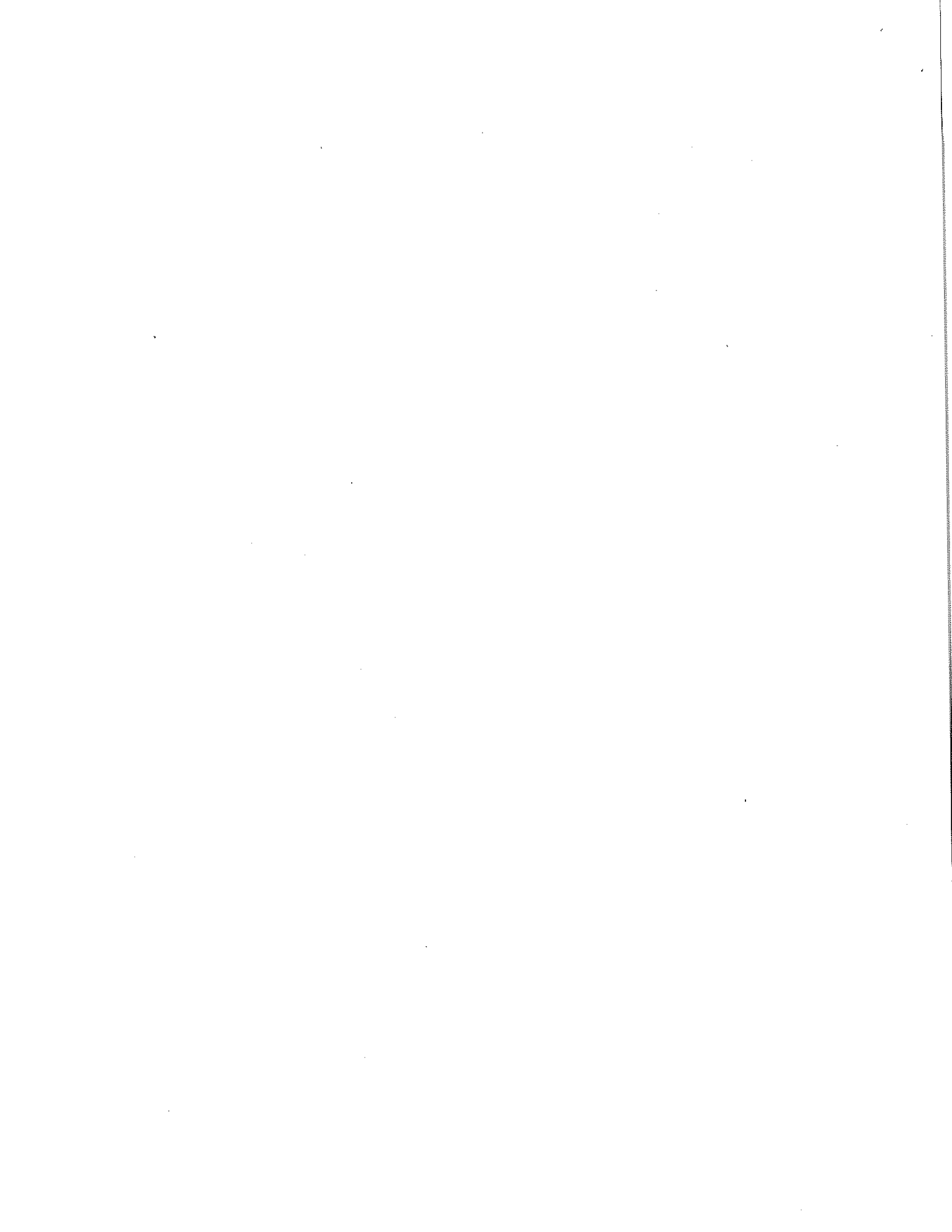

## **To Parents and Band Members**

Your Directors and Music Boosters are completing plans for the 2019 Band Camp. We hope you are looking forward to this week of work, study, and fun. The purpose of this camp is to prepare the Eagle Marching Band for the 2019 fall marching season.

**Band Camp is a pre-requisite for participation in band.**

### **FACTS ABOUT MARCHING BAND CAMP**

#### **DATES:**

Monday, July 29<sup>th</sup> through Friday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019

#### **PLACE:**

North Olmsted High School, North Olmsted OH

#### **TIMES:**

8am – 6:00pm (Monday - Wednesday)

8am - 10:00pm (Thursday Night) (Special Senior Evening Activity)

8am - 6:30pm (Friday) (End of Camp Performance)

#### **STAFF:**

2 Band Directors, 2 Eaglet Advisors, 1 Percussion Advisor, Multiple College/Alumni/Music Teacher Assistants, Parent Chaperones/Boosters

#### **FEES:**

Band Camp is FREE to attend. The hard work students do to fundraise throughout the year helps to pay for this week of learning. A mandatory uniform fee must be paid to supply each marcher with the necessary pieces and parts for their uniforms. The form will be available soon and no later than Band Camp. It will be posted on [www.eaglemusic.org](http://www.eaglemusic.org) and sent via email to all registered emails

#### **MEALS:**

Students are on their own for lunch each day. However, there is a free lunch provided at the school for students through a grant. On Thursday night there will be a dinner provided by NOBOB. It is our "evening activity" night.

#### **MEDICAL FORMS/Year Permission Slips:**

All Forms are due no later than **May 17th, 2019**. These forms serve as your reservation for band camp (and inclusion in the band drills and roster). Make sure that all forms are absolutely complete and signed with both parent and student signatures.

#### **E-MAILS:**

It is important to have valid and accurate e-mail addresses for both students and parents. Please make sure you have logged into charms and have updated these addresses! **MEDICAL:**

An emergency medical form and permission form must be completed **BEFORE** your son/daughter will be permitted to go to camp. If there is anything about your child's medical history we should know, please inform us. If you have problems with your knees or ankles, please bring knee and ankle supports. There will be a parent volunteer or staff on hand to handle any unexpected injuries or emergencies. If anything should happen, we will contact you ASAP.

Please carefully read the rules enclosed in this packet and sign and return the attached form.

**WHAT TO BRING:**

Water bottle (it gets hot, so stay hydrated)  
Clothing for warm and cold weather, Hat and/or Sunglasses  
Sunscreen, Rain gear, Blistex or chapstick  
2 pairs of GOOD marching shoes (athletic shoes made of leather or canvas, no vinyl or plastic, or sandals) (Your first shoes will be wet from dew. A second pair is good for the afternoon)

**COME PREPARED FOR HOT WEATHER, COLD WEATHER, ANY WEATHER!**

**INSTRUMENT:**

Be sure it is in EXCELLENT playing condition. (Brass players: This means all slides move) Bring valve oil, slide oil, **EXTRA REEDS**, extra drumsticks, and tape. Have your instrument inspected before band camp. **MUSIC LYRES AND FOLIOS ARE A MUST! – every local music store has these.**

### **PERCUSSIONIST/DRUMLINE:**

There is a mandatory drumline camp July 22- July 24th. These rehearsals will be from 5pm - 9pm at NOHS. Percussionists will also be having rehearsal throughout the summer. Our drumline instructor, Mr. Radwan, as well as the percussion section leader, will be contacting all percussionists before school is out. (Freshmen drumline members will be at the drumline camp rehearsal on the 24th, not the freshmen/leader rehearsal)

The drumline placement will be chosen based on need and ability by Mr. Kalish, Mr. Radwan, and the drumline section leader prior to the end of the school year through an audition process on May 22nd from 6-8pm.

### **SWINGS AND THINGS:**

It is a yearly custom to go to Swings 'n Things as a band on Wednesday night of Band Camp. (July 31st) All students are encouraged to participate. There is a fee associated with the participation. Please fill out the attached form and return it with payment along with the other forms.

## **BAND CAMP RULES**

1. Students are expected to be at ALL rehearsals and activities.
2. ABSOLUTELY no hazing will be tolerated.
3. The NOBOB chaperones and Camp staff must be obeyed and treated with respect. They have the same authority as the directors.
4. Students are permitted to leave campus during Camp only for lunch for an hour from around 12:00-1:00 each day. (Lunch time may adjust due to rehearsal productivity)
5. No excuses for tardiness will be accepted without prior approval.
6. No bare feet or sandals permitted on the marching field or parade block.
7. If needed: All prescription medication will be labeled and turned into the parent volunteers. Students are responsible for taking their own medications, but if necessary, will be reminded to do so by the volunteers.
8. In addition, all rules of North Olmsted High School, and North Olmsted City Schools will be in force during the entire duration of the Camp. Any violation of these rules will result in disciplinary action by the directors.
